Draft Purposes of Study Committee

- I. To understand the Lower Farmington River and Salmon Brook river corridors and to develop a management plan for the preservation of intact river ecosystems and regional resources.
- II. To develop a strong coalition of municipalities, citizens, and agencies for planning and implementing public education, land-use, recreation and conservation strategies.
- III. To determine whether the Lower Farmington River and Salmon Brook should be designated as a component of the National Wild and Scenic Rivers System and secure designation of those rivers as a component of the National Wild and Scenic River System if appropriate.
