ORV Planning– Responsible for reviewing and making recommendations to the full Study Committee regarding the Outstandingly Remarkable Resources of the Lower Farmington River and Salmon Brook that are believed to meet the criteria of the Wild & Scenic program. These values include the categories of natural, cultural and recreational resources.

Outreach & Education – Responsible for coordinating and implementing activities to engage local landowners, land use commissions and other community interests in the study process and provide educational opportunities regarding the unique resources of the study area.

Management & Protection Planning – Working with local community land use boards and other stakeholder interests, the subcommittee is responsible for drafting the management/protection plan for the study area’s outstandingly remarkable values.

Executive Committee – Responsible for addressing issues and concerns that may arise between regularly scheduled Study Committee meetings that are time sensitive, this may include reacting to activities in the watershed that could potentially have significant impact on “outstanding resource values”, funding issues, and general procedural issues.
